Rocky Bottom Retreat and Conference Center of the Blind is pleased to announce the annual summer camp for legally blind children. There will be one camp for children ages 6-13. This year's camp will run June 23-29, 2024. There will be no charge to attend and there will be a maximum of 15 campers. Supervised recreational activities may include hiking, arts and crafts, mountain climbing, water slides, games, swimming, cookouts, miniature golf, field trips, computer, braille activities and more, depending on availability. Senior and junior counselors and administrative personnel will be primarily legally blind individuals. This is a unique and important feature of the Rocky Bottom program. Family members are requested to accompany their child to Rocky Bottom on Sunday and also to return to camp on Friday to have lunch with us and watch your child in a camp-wide talent show. After the show, campers are free to leave with parents. Campers will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Limited transportation will be provided for those who cannot provide their own transportation. Designated pickup points will be assigned at a later date.
